- We have been informed of cases of Hand, Foot and mouth Disease in the elementary school. Please read the letter on the back for more information.

We have been informed of cases of Hand, Foot and Mouth Disease (Coxsackie Virus) in the elementary school. This is a mild illness with a blister-like rash on the hands, feet and/or mouth. A low-grade fever, poor appetite and sore throat may also occur. Symptoms may appear 3-6 days after a child is exposed and it is contagious from the onset of symptoms until the lesions are gone.

Hand, Foot and Mouth Disease is spread by direct contact with droplets from the nose and throat. It can also be spread through exposure to feces during toileting.

Prevention includes careful hand washing of children and adults, especially after toileting, as well as covering coughs and disposing of used tissues, followed by hand washing.

A student may return to school after being fever-free for 24 hours as long as he/she is able to participate in normal activities. If still feeling "under the weather", please keep your student home.
